

MINUTES Cochran City Council Tuesday, May 10, 2016 Regular Meeting @ 7:00 PM

Community House located at 192 South Third Street, Cochran, GA 31014

Present: Mayor Stoy, Councilmembers Gary Ates, Jon Thrower, Charles Cranford, Andrew Lemmon, Regina Gooch and Fleming Gilman.

Call to order by the Mayor. The invocation was given by Councilmember Ates followed by the Pledge of Allegiance led by Councilmember Thrower.

Councilmember Ates made a motion and Councilmember Thrower seconded the motion to adopt the agenda after adding speed bumps as agenda item #6. Motion passed unanimously with all voting in favor.

Councilmember Ates made a motion and Councilmember Lemmon seconded the motion to accept the April 12, 2016 work session and regular session minutes, the April 19, 2016 special called meeting minutes and the April 26, 2016 special called meeting minutes. Motion passed unanimously with all voting in favor.

Agenda Items

Item #1 – Presented by Mayor Mike Stoy

Proclamation for Peace Officers Memorial Day.

Mayor Stoy recognized the officers of the Cochran Police Department along with retired officers by reading the proclamation for Peace Officers Memorial Day effective May 15, 2016.

Item # 2 – Presented by City Manager Richard Newbern

Mutual aid agreement between the City of Cochran and Middle Georgia State University, Police Department. The mutual aid agreement allows the Cochran Police to provide assistance, if needed, to the Middle Georgia State University Police Department. Councilmember Lemmon made a motion and Councilmember Ates seconded the motion to authorize Mayor Stoy to sign the MOU on behalf of Council. Motion passed unanimously with all voting in favor.

Item # 3 – Presented by Mayor Stoy

Strategic Plan.

Councilmember Ates made a motion and Councilmember Thrower seconded the motion to approve the strategic plan. Motion passed unanimously with all voting in favor. The plan will be effective July 1, 2016.

Item # 4 – Presented by City Manager Richard Newbern

Resolution 12-16; Approve the complete closure of the City of Cochran's inert landfill.

Councilmember Thrower made a motion and Councilmember Ates seconded the motion to approve Resolution 12-16. Motion passed unanimously with all voting in favor.

Item # 5 - Presented by City Manager Richard Newbern

Resolution 13-16; Approve contract in the amount of \$186,616.00 to Commercial Fencing Co. for the Airport Fencing Phase II at the Cochran-Bleckley County Airport. Project is financed with federal, state and local funding. Councilmember Lemmon made a motion and Councilmember Ates seconded the motion to approve Resolution 13-16. Motion passed unanimously with all voting in favor.

Item # 6 - Presented by City Manager Richard Newbern

Approval for speed bumps on Johnson Street.

Public Works Director Jacob Daniels informed Council that concrete speed bumps are permanent and cannot be removed. Council determined that asphalt speed bumps would be sufficient. Councilmember Ates made a motion and Councilmember Gooch seconded the motion for approval of speed bumps on Johnson Street. Motion passed unanimously with all voting in favor.

Mayor Updates

Mayor Stoy gave an update on Kuhmo Tire.

Department updates - Handouts were provided to each councilmember.

Skip Layton stated that the Peyton Williams area is in need of better drainage. Also, the radio read system for water meters will be ready to bid at the end of May. Rehab on the water tanks will also go out for bid.

The downtown parking plans were submitted to DOT for approval.

Chief Kevin Noles introduced Matt Hancock as a new firefighter. Mr. Hancock will also be in charge of training.
