Ordinance -10-15; Automatic Adjustment Clause. To cover annual expenses, the City will automatically increase utility rates for the usage of water, sewer, natural gas and solid waste garbage services in accordance with any increase represented by the United States Social Security administration's annual cost of living adjustment (C.P.O.LA.). Such increase if any, will take effect on January 1st of each year. Annual automatic increases shall not exceed 4% in any given year, without the specific approval of the City Council of the City of Cochran.
